


Youth Training: Leading with Attitude and Skills





1956, A New Way of Thinking



- Cognitive: mental skills (Knowledge)
- **Psychomotor**: manual or physical skills (**S**kills)
- Affective: growth in feelings or emotional areas (Attitude)

KSAs
